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Yosemite West Forest Restoration Program Application

The Mariposa County Resource Conservation District (MCRCD) has a new program to assist residents in reducing fuel loading in and around the community. Community protection is tiered to prioritize fuels reduction treatments:

1. From homes and structures
2. Along roads within the community
3. Wildland Urban Interface
4. Primary and secondary roads radiating away from the communities that can be used for egress, fuel breaks necessary to implement prescribed fire treatments, or as fuel breaks to halt wildfire.

Withing Yosemite West specifically, this project will:

- Remove dead and down, and hazard trees, and thin/chip brush and small conifers (up to 20" in diameter) from private properties

Logs within 50 feet of rivers, creeks or streams cannot be removed due to environmental regulations.

Applications must be completed in full, and will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Downed tree removal and wood waste disposal services will be performed based on availability of funding. Scheduling will be determined by when work is being undertaken in your community. Applications must be accompanied by a signed right of entry and CEQA Exemption forms.

A site visit to assess fuels and downed trees will also be conducted. Once all required documents have been received, you will be contacted and advised of your application status.

Program Requirements

1. Applicants must complete and sign Program Application, **including Assessor's Parcel Number** from the property tax bill.
2. Applicants must sign a Right of Entry permission form.
