MOW, THEREFORE, this Board hereby determines and orders that the Yosemite West Maintenance District Advisory Board be established as follows:

I. MEMBERSHIP

- a. The Yosemite West Maintenance District Advisory

 Board shall be made up of five residents and/or

 property owners from within the service area boundaries.
- b. The Supervisor of the Fifth Supervisorial District shall be a non-voting ex-officio member of the Advisory Board.

II. TERM AND MANNER OF APPOINTMENT

a. Appointment to the Advisory Board shall be for a term of three years.

- c. All meetings shall be public and noticed in accordance with established County policy.
- d. All meetings of the Advisory Board shall be conducted in accordance with "Roberts Rules of Order".

V. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Prior to any decision by the Board of Directors in regard to annexation or other adjustments or any matters relative to contracts or agreements outside the service area boundaries opportunity shall be given to the Advisory Board to review, comment, and offer recommendations to the Board of Directors.

THIS BOARD OF DIRECTORS FURTHER DETERMINES AND ORDERS, that the Yosemite West Maintenance District shall discharge its responsibilities, as assigned, in a manner in keeping with established County policy and with the support of the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors.

The Board of Directors will provide clerical and staff support to the Advisory Board, as required. The Advisory Board shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors.
